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Program Summary

- Stations under first phase of program:
 - Fire Station 7 (Castro Valley)
 - Fire Station 25 (Castro Valley)
 - Fire Station 22 (San Lorenzo)
- Fire Station Builds are being procured using Design-Build method
- First round of project consultants have been procured (PM/CM, Bridging Architect, CEQA)
- Started Concept Design of FS 7 and 25; goal to complete bridging documents by Q2 2024
- Preliminary concept design for FS 22 is complete



Fire Station 7 (Palomares Hill)

- 6855 Villareal Dr
- Station is being built adjacent to existing fire station
- Primary apparatus:
 - Type 1 engine
- Daily Staffing
 - (3) personnel



Fire Station 25 Castro Valley

- 20336 San Miguel Ave
- Station being built on same site as current station
- Primary apparatus:
 - Type 1 engine
 - Tiller truck
 - Battalion Chief
- Daily Staffing
 - (8) personnel



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Fire Station 22 San Lorenzo

- 587 Paseo Grande
- Station being built on new site (purchase of site is currently in process)
- Primary apparatus:
 - Type 1 engine
- Daily Staffing
 - (3) personnel



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Planned Next Steps

- Conceptual designs will be developed over the next 2 to 3 months
- Project team plans to present update to CV MAC in November
